ROAD TOUR AND PUBLIC MEETING

The Road Inspection meeting began at 5:30 p.m. There were no persons in the audience. The Officials present were:

The meeting began with a discussion of the status of the 2008 road surfacing and drainage program. The Supervisors also discussed a letter written by Attorney Charles Means to the Consolidated Gas Transmission Corporation regarding an erosion problem which is affecting the berm area of North Montour Road. Mr. Reichart and Mr. Shoup reported on alternative strategies for improving the northern third of North Montour Road .

Next, the Supervisors discussed establishing a policy for the installation and removal of scholastic championship team signs. At the conclusion of the discussion the Supervisors authorized the Secretary to coordinate a policy regarding the signs with Pine Township which shall include the following components.

1. All future signs shall be paid for by either the School District or the booster organizations affiliated with the championship team.
2. The length of time during which the sign shall remain posted shall not exceed two years, after which they will be returned to the organization which purchased them.
3. The size of any individual championship team sign shall not exceed 30" x 9"; and.
4. The Township public works department shall install and remove the signs.

The policy was unanimously approved by all Supervisors present.

The Supervisors boarded two vehicles and began the tour.

North Montour Road

The Supervisors drove the length of the road viewing: the construction work near the Route 910 intersection, the physical condition of the paving work which was completed in 2005 and 2006, the erosion within the Consolidated Gas transmission right-of-way and the condition of the uncompleted portion of the road.

Rockwood Drive

The Supervisors examined the condition of the island in the vicinity of 711 Rockwood Drive. The Board instructed the Secretary to monitor the extent to which parked cars affect the access to this portion of the street.

New Municipal Building

The Supervisors toured the new municipal building.

At the conclusion of the tour the Supervisors adjourned the public meeting and went to dinner.
