PUBLIC MEETING

The Richland Township Board of Supervisors meeting held at the municipal building on Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. was called to order by Chairman, Raymond Kendrick. There were approximately twenty-six people present in the audience. The Officials present were:

He also acknowledged the good work and dedication Mr. Palmer and Ms. Shaw. At the conclusion of his presentation the following participants took turns to play Richland's version of "The Price is Right."

Mr. Allen made a motion to approve of the minutes from Supervisors Road Program/MS-4 Stormwater Management Meeting and Public Meeting of April 3, 2019. Ms. Snyder seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Kendrick asked if anyone in the audience wished to speak.

Mr. Cal Miller, 6006 Linwood Drive, said that he enjoyed “The Price is Right” game and said he wished more residents knew how expensive the equipment used by the Township emergency response organizations was.

Ms. Snyder made a motion to approve the March 2019 Financial, PLGIT Mastercard, #92371 - #92398 and ACH Transfer Account, #1292-#1303. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Mr. Allen made a motion to approve the bills payable in the following amounts: General PLGIT, \$37,087.45, Sewer Fund, \$60,532.98 and Highway Improvement Capital Reserve, \$512.49. Mr. Marshall seconded the motion and it was approved by all.

Dividend Checks from Municipal Risk Management (MRM)

At the ALOM Conference at Seven Springs, Ms. Snyder attended the annual Municipal Risk Management meeting at which dividend checks were distributed. She returned with two checks. One in the amount of \$16,182.59 represented 55% return of The Workers Compensation premium. The second check in the amount of \$6,961.35 representing 61.8% of the Township’s property insurance premium.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 504 establishing a ten (10) ton weight limit on Ben Miller Road. Ms. Snyder seconded the motion and it was approved by all.
