TOWNSHIP OF RICHLAND
RESOLUTION NO. 15 OF 2021**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHLAND, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDS TO PAY FOR GENERAL GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE TOWNSHIP'S SANITARY SEWERAGE SYSTEM, TO THE EXTENT OF LOST REVENUES CALCULATED AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2020, ACCORDING TO THE INTERIM FINAL RULES ISSUED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY.

WHEREAS the American Rescue Plan identified reductions in revenues as an eligible use of COVID Rescue Funds, and

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of the Treasury has issued Final Interim Rules for the calculation of revenue loss, and

WHEREAS consistent with Treasury Department guidance the Township has performed revenue replacement calculations, which indicate a Township revenue loss of \$468,435, based upon comparison of Base Year December 31, 2019 to Calendar Year December 31, 2020, and

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Township Manager and Finance Officer are authorized to disburse \$468,435, representing Township lost revenue, from the American Rescue Plan Fund to the Sewer Revenue Fund to pay for general governmental services related sanitary sewers.
2. A copy of the cost revenue calculation is attached as Addendum "A".
